A. Finance Council Committee:

1. Motion to (approve, table, not approve) the transfer \$21,186.52, which was deposited automatically by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania into the Borough's general fund for the 2016 state allocation in accordance with Act 205 of 1984, from the Borough of Donora's general fund to the Volunteer Fire Relief Association of the Donora Volunteer Fire company.

2. Motion to (approve, table, not approve) the payment of invoice # 468490 dated September 14, 2016 from Maher Duessel CPAs of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania in the amount of \$2,600.00 for the final billing for professional services rendered in connection with audit services for the Borough of Donora for the year ended December 31, 2015.
