

ORDINANCE NO. 1009

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF DONORA, WASHINGTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, VACATING A PORTION OF NOROSKI ALLEY IN THE BOROUGH OF DONORA, WASHINGTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Donora, in regular meeting assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by virtue of the authority in them vested, as follows, to-wit:

Section 1. That the portion of Noroski Alley in the Borough of Donora, Pennsylvania, which lies between Walnut Street and Wolf Alley, be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent herewith.
