

TAX ORDINANCE

ORDINANCE NO. 1013

AN ORDINANCE of the Borough of Donora, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, fixing the tax rate for the fiscal year of 1961.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Donora, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

SECTION 1. That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property and occupations within the said Borough subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the fiscal year 1961, as follows:

Tax rate for general Borough purposes, the sum of fifteen (15) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation;

For debt purposes the sum of one and one-half ($1\frac{1}{2}$) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation;

For lighting purposes, the sum of one and one-half ($1\frac{1}{2}$) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation;

Making a total tax rate for all Borough purposes of eighteen (18) mills.

SECTION 2. That any ordinance, or part of ordinance, conflicting with this ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.
