

ORDINANCE NUMBER 103

OHIO STREET GRADE

AN ORDINANCE fixing and establishing the grade of Ohio Street, in the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Donora, in the County of Washington and State of Pennsylvania, in regular meeting assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section 1. That the grade of Ohio Street, in said borough, be and the same is hereby fixed and established as follows, to-wit:

East Curb Line--Beginning at the North curb line of Liberty Avenue, at an elevation of 909 feet, and falling at the rate of 1.612 per cent for a distance of 312 feet to an elevation of 908.50 feet; thence falling at the rate of 3.296 per cent for a distance of 126.87 feet to an elevation of 904.32 feet; thence falling at the rate of 4.55 per cent for a distance of 410 feet to an elevation of 902.50 feet, at the North curb line of Prospect Avenue.

West Curb Line--Beginning at the South curb line of Liberty Avenue, at an elevation of 909 feet, and falling at the rate of 3.296 per cent for a distance of 166.87 feet to an elevation of 903.50 feet, at the North curb line of Prospect Avenue.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
