

ORDINANCE NO. 1066

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE SALE OF 200,000 TONS OF SLAG, 25,000 TONS OF CINDERS, AND OTHER MATERIALS.

WHEREAS, United States Steel Corporation, a Delaware corporation, has granted a license to the Borough of Donora to remove 200,000 tons of slag, 25,000 tons of cinders, and other materials stored or placed on about 422 acres of land in Carroll Township, Washington County, Pennsylvania, shown as Tract 4 on a plan of United States Steel Corporation designated "Location Plan of United States Steel Corporation Property at Donora Works, Washington County, Pa.," dated May, 1966; and

WHEREAS, United States Steel Corporation has made a gift of said slag, cinders and other materials to the Borough of Donora; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of Donora desires to sell said slag, cinders and other materials in accordance with the provisions of the Borough Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the Borough of Donora hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. That the sale of the said slag, cinders and other materials is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. That the proper officers of the Borough are hereby authorized, directed and empowered, after the highest and best bid therefore shall have been accepted by council in pursuance to public advertising made, to execute a contract or contracts with the successful bidder for the sale of the said

200,000 tons of slag, 25,000 tons of cinders and other materials. Such contract or contracts shall, inter alia, provide for the filing of proper bonds by the contractor or contractors.
