

ORDINANCE NO. 1084

WHEREAS, the Borough of Donora desires to have plans and specifications prepared for work projects within Palmer Park consistent with the Park Development Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Donora is desirous of obtaining State financial aid in improving the park; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Donora desires to engage its consultant, Mullin and Lonergan Associates, Inc., to prepare plans and specifications for certain work projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted and ordained and it is hereby ordained and enacted as follows:

I. The Borough of Donora shall enter into a contract with its consultant, Mullin and Lonergan Associates, Inc., to prepare the plans and specifications for the following work projects to be undertaken in Palmer Park during the summer of 1968:

- A. Restrooms and First Aid Room
- B. Pavilion - (two)
- C. Underground electric to #1 & #2 above
- D. New water lines to #1 & #2 above and ballfield
- E. Fencing - two ballfields
- F. Resurfacing Tennis Courts
- G. Resurfacing portion of main access road (7/10 mile)
- H. Drinking fountains and benches
- I. Walks
- J. Landscaping

II. The Consultant will also prepare the proper State application, Part I of Project 500 State Grant Program for Borough Council approval.

III. The fee for the work performed and carried out by the Consultant shall be 8% of the actual construction costs for those work projects listed in

Section 1 above. The Consultant shall be paid 4% of the estimated cost upon completion of plans and specifications and the remainder upon receipt of the first grant payment from the State.

IV. That the proper officials of the Borough of Donora are hereby directed and authorized to execute the contract for professional services between the Borough of Donora and Mullin and Lonergan Associates, Inc.
