

ORDINANCE NUMBER 111

LINCOLN AVENUE GRADE

AN ORDINANCE fixing and establishing the grade of Lincoln Avenue, in the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Donora, in the County of Washington and State of Pennsylvania, in regular meeting assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section 1. That the grade of Lincoln Avenue, in said borough, be and the same is hereby fixed and established as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the North curb line of McCrea Avenue at an elevation of 960.40 feet and rising at the rate of 2.76 per cent for a distance of 50 feet to an elevation of 962.15 feet; thence falling at the rate of 1.01 per cent for a distance of 263.62 feet to an elevation of 959.52 feet; thence falling at the rate of .56 per cent for a distance of 150 feet to an elevation of 958.67 feet at the South curb line of First Street.

West Curb Line.--Beginning at the North curb line of McCrea Avenue at an elevation of 962.60 feet; thence falling at the rate of 1.01 per cent for a distance of 455.23 feet to an elevation of 958 feet at the South curb line of First Street.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed.
