

ORDINANCE NO. 1118

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF DONORA, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF AN INTERMUNICIPAL POLICE COOPERATION AGREEMENT BY AND AMONG THE SEVERAL MUNICIPALITIES IN THE MID-MONONGAHELA VALLEY.

WHEREAS, the several municipalities of the Mid-Monongahela Valley desire to establish an Intermunicipal Police Cooperation Agreement providing for a procedure to transfer police officers of one municipality to another municipality for the latter's assistance.

AND NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Borough Council of Donora, and it is hereby Ordained and Enacted by authority of the same as follows:


SECTION ONE: Borough of Donora shall enter into an Intermunicipal Police Cooperation Agreement with the several municipalities of the Mid-Monongahela Valley substantially in the form of the agreement presented to this meeting, dated as of June 1, 1971, which is hereby made a part hereof by reference only and is on file with the Executive Director of the Mid-Mon Valley Council of Governments.

SECTION TWO: The President of Borough Council is hereby directed to execute and deliver to the other parties hereto, on behalf of the Borough, the said agreement substantially in the form of the said agreement, which agreement when consummated shall be attested to by the municipal secretary.

SECTION THREE: The said agreement shall be maintained in the form of a master agreement in possession and control of the Executive Director of the Mid-Mon Valley Council of Governments.
