

ORDINANCE NO. 1165

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by Council of the Borough of Donora, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same:

Section 1. Throwing snow in street.

It shall be unlawful for any person to throw, shovel, cast or otherwise move, place, pile, deposit or dump snow or ice removed from sidewalks, driveways or other areas into the streets or public highways, or for any person, when the cartway of the street or highway shall be cleared or partially cleared, to throw or place any snow or any other accumulation in the cleared cartway or passageway area.

Section 2. Penalties.

Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction before a Magistrate pay a fine of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) together with costs of prosecution, and in default of payment undergo imprisonment for not more than five (5) days.

Section 3. Any ordinance or part of an ordinance conflicting with this ordinance is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.
