

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1169

(3 of 1978)

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND CORRECTING ORDINANCE NUMBER 524 of 1921.

WHEREAS, on December 19, 1921, the Council of the Borough of Donora enacted Ordinance No. 524 which vacated a portion of Seventh Street in the Borough, and

WHEREAS, the property vacated was awarded to the abutting owners subject to existing equities, and

WHEREAS, the Third Parcel of Section One of Ordinance 524 vacated by the Borough was erroneously described.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION I. That Ordinance No. 524 is hereby amended and the legal description of the Third Parcel, Parcel Three, as set forth in Section One of that Ordinance is hereby corrected.

SECTION II. That the proper description of Parcel Three is as follows:

Beginning at the north east corner of Seventh Street and Heslep Avenue, which is also the south west corner of Block No. 20 of the Union Improvement Company's Plan for the Borough of Donora; thence in an easterly direction along the northern line of Seventh Street and an unnumbered lot, South 84 degrees 9½ minutes east, 34 feet to the corner of lot of W. W. Dennis.

SECTION III. That the proper officers of the Borough are hereby authorized to execute and deliver whatever instruments are requisite to properly effectuate this amendment and correction of Ordinance No. 524.

SECTION IV. That all remaining provisions of Ordinance No. 524 shall remain in full force and effect.
