

ORDINANCE 1173

(7 of 1978)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF DONORA ESTABLISHING AND/OR RE-ESTABLISHING THOMPSON AVENUE BETWEEN SECOND STREET AND FOURTH STREET AS A TWO-WAY AVENUE AND FOURTH STREET BETWEEN MCKEAN AVENUE AND THOMPSON AVENUE AS A TWO-WAY STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION I. That that section of Thompson Avenue which lies between Second Street and Fourth Street is hereby established or re-established as a two-way Avenue.

SECTION II. That the flow of traffic from the date of enactment of this Ordinance shall be North to South respectively and South to North respectively.

SECTION III. That that section of Fourth Street which lies between McKean Avenue and Thompson Avenue is hereby established or re-established as a two-way street.

SECTION IV. That the flow of traffic on said Fourth Street from the date of enactment of this Ordinance shall be East to West respectively and West to East respectively.

SECTION V. Any person who shall operate a vehicle on those portions of Thompson Avenue and Fourth Street in a direction other than those directions set forth in this Ordinance shall be guilty of a summary offense and, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) and costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, be sentenced to imprisonment in the Washington County Jail for not more than five (5) days.
