

ORDINANCE NO. 1183

(1 of 1980)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF DONORA AMENDING ORDINANCE 1135 REGARDING POLICE PENSIONS.

SECTION I: That Article VII Section 1 (b) of Ordinance 1135 is hereby amended to read as follows: "Seventy-five per centum of the primary benefits under Federal Social Security Laws for which the officer may be eligible because of age or because of disability."

SECTION II: That Article VII Section I (d) of Ordinance 1135 is hereby amended to read as follows: "A policeman retiring with a service incurred disability shall receive a pension of fifty (50) percent of the monthly average salary of such member during the last thirty-six (36) months of employment. For purposes of this Ordinance, service incurred disability means total and permanent disability of a member prior to eligibility for superannuation retirement resulting from a condition arising out of and incurred in the course of his employment and which is compensable under the applicable provisions of 'The Pennsylvania Workmen's Compensation Act' or 'The Pennsylvania Occupational Disease Act'."
