

ORDINANCE NO. 1193

(2 of 1981)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF DONORA PROHIBITING THE USE AND OPERATION OF UNREGISTERED, TWO-WHEELED, SELF-PROPELLED VEHICLES, COMMONLY KNOWN AS "DIRT BIKES," WITHIN THE CORPORATE MUNICIPAL LIMITS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF DONORA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: It shall, henceforth, be unlawful for any person to use and/or operate "Dirt Bikes" within the corporate municipal limits of this Borough.

SECTION II: For purposes of this Ordinance, a "Dirt Bike" shall be defined as a two-wheeled, self-propelled vehicle which does not require registration under the Motor Vehicle Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, to be operated or driven. The size of the motor shall not be determinative as to whether or not the vehicle is a "Dirt Bike."

SECTION III: Any adult individual who shall violate the terms of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon conviction before the District Justice, be subject to the costs of prosecution and a fine of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00).

Any minor individual who shall violate the terms of this Ordinance shall be subject to the same penalties. If prosecution cannot be obtained before the District Justice because of the individual's minority, then proceedings shall be instituted in and through the Court of Common Pleas of Washington County, Juvenile Court Division.

SECTION IV: When the conduct proscribed by the terms of this Ordinance is also a violation of the Vehicle Code, the charge shall be brought under the Vehicle Code and not this Ordinance and the assessment and disposition of the fines and forfeitures shall be so governed.
