

ORDINANCE NUMBER 120

UNION STEEL COMPANY R. OF W. WEST COLUMBIA

AN ORDINANCE granting to the Union Steel Company the right to construct, maintain and operate a railroad track upon Second Street in West Columbia Plan of Lots, of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania.

Section 1. Be it ordained and enacted by the town council of the Borough of Donora in Council assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same that the Union Steel Company, its successors and assigns, be and are hereby granted the right to construct, maintain and operate a single track railroad with turnouts upon Second Street, West Columbia, from the Southwesterly side of Fair View Street in a Northeasterly direction, a distance of 2610 feet more or less, to the Northeasterly side of Sassafras Street.

Section 2. The Union Steel Company in consideration for the privilege of the use of said Second Street for this purpose, shall maintain a good roadway upon said Second Street, from said Fair View Street to said Sassafras Street.

The Union Steel Company shall construct and maintain plank street crossings over said railroad track at Chestnut Street, Market Street and Walnut Street.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
