

ORDINANCE No. 1220

(3 of 1985)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF DONORA REGULATING THE PARKING OF
MOTOR VEHICLES ON MCKEAN AVENUE BETWEEN FIFTH AND SEVENTH STREETS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Donora
as follows:

SECTION ONE: That during the term of the renovation/reconstruction of
the business section, the parking of motor vehicles shall be regulated as
follows:

A) In those areas where meters presently stand, the parking
of motor vehicles shall be regulated by the time gradations on
said meters;

B) In those areas where meters have been removed, motor vehicles
shall be permitted to park for a time period of no more than sixty
(60) minutes without penalty.

SECTION TWO: The terms of this Ordinance and the penalties affixed
hereto shall be enforced in the same manner as prior legislation of Council
regulating overtime parking.

The terms of those Ordinances consistent with this Ordinance
are hereby expressly ratified and prior inconsistent Ordinances are hereby
repealed.

SECTION THREE: The effective date of this Ordinance shall be October 10,
1985.
