

ORDINANCE NUMBER 132

HULL ALLEY VACATE (WEST COLUMBIA ADDITION)

AN ORDINANCE vacating a certain portion of Hull Alley, in that portion lately annexed to the borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, commonly known as West Columbia.

WHEREAS, a majority in number and interest of the owners of real property abutting on the line thereof, have petitioned the council of the said borough of Donora which petition is verified by affidavit, to enact an ordinance vacating that portion of Hull Alley, situate in that portion lately annexed to said borough, commonly known as West Columbia, which portion of said alley is hereinafter described.

WHEREAS, the said council deeming it necessary and proper that the portion of said Hull Alley, hereinafter described, be vacated, and desiring that the same be done therefore.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, in regular meeting assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section 1. That the portion of Hull Alley situate in that portion lately annexed to said borough, commonly known as West Columbia, from a point Sixty (60) feet Northerly from the North line of Chestnut Street, Northeastwardly Six Hundred and Eighty (685) feet, more or less, to the Northerly line of what was formerly West Columbia, be and the same is hereby vacated as an alley.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts thereof, in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed.

Ordained and enacted into an ordinance this 9th. day of March, A. D., 1905.


