

ORDINANCE NUMBER 144

REVOKING ORDINANCE OF DONORA CARROLL STREET RAILWAY

ORDINANCE revoking an ordinance granting the Donora & Carroll Street Railway company certain rights in the Borough of Donora, Washington county, Pennsylvania.

Whereas, on April 4th, 1904, the town council of the Borough of Donora passed an ordinance granting unto the Donora & Carroll Street Railway company a right to enter upon, lay its tracks and operate its lines on certain streets of the said borough and

Whereas it is provided by said ordinance that the said Donora & Carroll Street Railway company shall begin the construction of its lines and complete the same within one year from the date of said ordinance, and

Whereas, the said Donora & Carroll Street Railway company has neglected and refused to begin the construction of its lines and has not therefore its lines in operation.

Be it ordained and enacted by the town council of the Borough of Donora, in the county of Washington, and state of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

That all franchises, rights, liberties and privileges which the said Donora & Carroll Street Railway company now owns and possesses under and by virtue of and ordinance dated April 14th, 1904, and approved April 5th, 1904, be hereby revoked, annuled and made void, the conditions of said ordinance not having been complied with by the said Street Railway company.

ORDAINED and ENACTED into an ordinance this 18th day of September, A. D. 1905.
