

ORDINANCE NUMBER 183

CONSTRUCTION OF TRUNK SEWER ON 7TH STREET CYPRESS ALLEY TO McKEAN AVENUE.

AN ORDINANCE, authorizing the extension of the Seventh street trunk sewer, in Seventh street from its present terminus at Cypress Alley to the manhole at the intersection of McKean avenue and providing for the payment of the costs thereof,

Whereas, there is no public sewer in Seventh street, in the Borough of Donora Washington County, Pennsylvania, between Cypress Alley and McKean avenue, and the council of the said borough deems that the general welfare of the public requires that a sewer be constructed therein, and:-

Whereas, in the construction of said sewer it is necessary, in order to properly take care of the drainage and sewerage of the borough, that the same be a part of the trunk sewer system of the borough, and said council desires to construct said sewer, and pay for the same out of the general fund of the borough, therefore:-

Be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section 1---That the Seventh street trunk sewer, be and the same is hereby authorized and directed to be extended, along Seventh street from its present western terminus at the manhole, at the intersection of Cypress Alley, extending westwardly along said Seventh street, to the manhole at the intersection of McKean avenue a distance of 170 feet, that such sewer shall be constructed of terra cotta sewer pipe of the diameter of eighteen (18) inches, and according to the plans and specifications of the Borough Engineer, approved by the president of the council and the committee on highways and sewers.

Section 2---That the president of council and the chairman of the committee on highways and sewers are hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and receive proposals for the construction of said sewer as aforesaid; they are hereby authorized upon the approval of the same by the council of said borough, to let contract or contracts therefor to any responsible party or parties, such being the lowest bidder or bidders, such party or parties to give satisfactory security to complete the work in strict conformity with plans and specifications which shall be furnished by the Borough Engineer so approved as aforesaid, and work shall be done under the direction and supervision of the Borough Engineer.

Section 3---That the costs and expense, of the extension of said sewer shall be paid by the said borough of Donora out of the general fund thereof.-

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Ordained and enacted into an ordinance this 7th day of June, A. D. 1909.
