

ORDINANCE NUMBER 189

LINDEN ALLEY SEWER 8TH NORTH TO LOT 3 BLOCK 48.

AN ORDINANCE, authorizing the adoption and construction of a public sewer on a portion of Linden Alley, in the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, and providing for the payment of the costs of the construction thereof.

Whereas, it appears that there is no public sewerage in Linden Alley, between the south line of lot No. 30, in block No. 48, and Eighth street, in said borough to take care of the waste water and other sewerage matter from the land adjoining the same, in said borough on the west side of said alley, and the council of said borough deems it necessary that a public sewer be constructed and adopted in said Linden alley, between the points aforesaid, for the disposal of waste water and other sewerage as aforesaid, and are desirous to construct such sewer, therefore:-

Be it ordained and enacted by the council of the Borough of Donora, in the County of Washington and State of Pennsylvania, in a regular meeting met and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section 1---That a public sewer, be, and the same is hereby authorized to be adopted and constructed in Linden Alley between the south line of lot No. 30, in block No 48, and Eighth street; said sewer shall be constructed of Terra Cotta sewer pipe of the diameter of ten inches and in strict conformity to the plans and specifications of the Borough Engineer, approved by the President of Council and the Committee on Highways and Sewers of said borough.

Section 2---That the President of Council and the Chairman of the Committee on Highways and Sewers are hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and receive proposals for the construction of said sewer as aforesaid; that are hereby authorized upon the approval of the same by the council, to let contract or contracts therefor, to any responsible party or parties, such being the lowest bidder or bidders, and upon such party or parties giving satisfactory security to complete the work in strict conformity with the plans and specifications which shall be furnished by the Borough Engineer, so approved as aforesaid, and work shall be done under the supervision and direction of the Borough Engineer and the Committee on Highways and Sewers.

Section 3---That the cost and expenses of the construction of said sewer shall be ascertained upon the completion of the same, and shall be assessed as a sewer tax upon the properties abounding and abutting on the west side of said Linden Alley between the points aforesaid, in accordance with the foot front rule, and be collected under the provisions of the Act of Assembly of said Commonwealth, approved May 15th, 1889, and the several supplements and amendments thereof, relating to and regulating the same.

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Section 4---All ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed.

Ordained and enacted into an ordinance, this 4th day of October, 1909.
