

ORDINANCE NUMBER 191

PROHIBITING FIRING FIRECRACKERS, CANNONS, GUNS.

AN ORDINANCE, prohibiting the firing of any cannon, gun, rifle,, pistol, toy pistol, or firearms of any kind; the firing or exploding of any squib, rocket, cracker or Roman candle, or other combustible fireworks, and the making use of any sling, in any of the streets, avenues, lanes, alleys, or public places, within the borough of Donora, and fixing a penalty for the violation thereof.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1---That from and after the enactment and publication of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person, persons, firm or corporation, to fire any cannon, gun, rifle, pistol, toy pistol, or firearms of any kind or fire or explode any squib, rocket, cracker or Roman Candle, or other combustible fireworks, or make use of any sling, in any of the streets, avenues, lanes, alleys or public places, within the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania.

Section 2---That any person, persons, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof before the Burgess of said borough, or any Justice of the Peace thereof, be fined in a sum not less than five (\$5.00) dollars, or more than twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars, and costs of suit, and in default of the payment of the fine imposed, and costs of suit, shall be confined in the Borough Lock-Up for a period not exceeding 5 days.
