ORDINANCE NUMBER 215 VACATING HULL ALLEY IN WEST COLUMBIA

AN ORDINANCE providing for the vacation of a certain part of Hull Alley, in the Plan of West Columbia, in the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, in regular Council assembled, and it is ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section 1. That the part of Hull Alley, in the Plan of West Columbia, in the Borough of Donora, said county and state, lying between the North line of Market Street, and the North terminus thereof, North of Chestnut Street in said plan, be and the same is hereby vacated as an alley and thoroughfare.

Section 2. All ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with this ordinance, be and the same is hereby repealed.
