ORDINANCE NUMBER 640 VACATION OF A PORTION OF WASHINGTON ALLEY. (REPEALING ORDINANCE #629) AN ORDINANCE providing for the vacation of a portion of Washington Alley, and repealing ordinance No. 629, and directing the entry of such changes upon the official plans of the highways of the Borough of Donora. WHEREAS the School District of the Borough of Donora has either by purchase or condemnation proceedings, obtained the title to several properties in the Borough of Donora South of Fifth, fronting on Waddell Avenue, and extending back to Washington Alley: and WHEREAS such School District has also similarly acquired a tract of land in Carroll Township immediately abutting on Washington Alley opposite the rear of such other properties: and WHEREAS such District, in order to join up the seperate properties into one plot, has requested the Borough of Donora to cause such Washington Alley to be vacated at the points hereinafter given, and has agreed to pay all costs and damages; therefore, - BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Donora in regular meeting assembled, and it is ordained and enacted by virtue of the authority in them vested, as follows, to wit: SECTION 1 --- That that portion of Washington Alley, as shown on the general plan of the Borough, which lies between the extension of the line dividing lots Nos. 25 and 26 in block No. 39 of the Union Improvement Company's Plan of Donora and the extension of the line dividing lots Nos. 32 and 33 in said block No. 39, be and the same is hereby vacated and closed permanently as an alley or a thoroughfare. SECTION 2 --- That the Borough Engineer shall and he is hereby directed to make the changes provided for by this vacation upon the official plan of the town of Donora. SECTION 3 --- That Ordinance No. 629 and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. ORDAINED AND ENACTED into an ordinance this 7th day of July A. D. 1930.
