

ORDINANCE NUMBER 644

RE-ESTABLISHING THE GRADE OF WADDELL AVENUE FROM FIRST STREET TO FIFTH STREET.

AN ORDINANCE re-establishing the grade of Waddell Avenue from First Street to Fifth Street in the Borough of Donora.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Chief Burgess and Council of the Borough of Donora, Pa., and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the same, by virtue of the powers in them vested, as follows, to wit:

SECTION 1---That Waddell Avenue, from First Street to Fifth Street in the Borough of Donora, Pa., be and the same is hereby re-established as follows:

EAST CURB LINE: Beginning at the intersection with the North curb line of First Street, at an elevation of 957.0 feet; thence rising at the rate of 2.85 per cent, for a distance of 74.11 feet, to an elevation of 959.11 feet; thence by a concave parabola, for a distance of 60.0 feet, to an elevation of 962.10 feet; thence rising at the rate of 7.08 per cent, for a distance of 197.97 feet to an elevation of 974.0 feet at the North curb line of Second Street; thence rising at the rate of 7.257 per cent, for a distance of 263.16 feet to an elevation of 1016.25 feet at the North curb line of Third Street; thence rising at the rate of 4.668 per cent, for a distance of 187.41 feet to an elevation of 1025.0 feet; thence rising at the rate of 2.35 per cent, for a distance of 127.54 feet to an elevation of 1028.0 feet at the North curb line of Fourth Street; thence rising at the rate of 0.418 per cent, for a distance of 112.46 feet to an elevation of 1028.47 feet; thence by a convex parabola, for a distance of 100.0 feet to an elevation of 1024.68 feet; thence falling at the rate of 8.0 per cent for a distance of 108.54 feet, to an elevation of 1016.0 feet at the North curb line of Fifth Street.

WEST CURB LINE: Beginning at the intersection with the South curb line of First Street, at an elevation of 957.21 feet; thence falling at the rate of 0.958 per cent, for a distance of 21.87 feet to an elevation of 957.0 feet; thence rising at the rate of 2.85 per cent, for a distance of 74.11 feet, to an elevation of 959.11 feet; thence by a concave parabola for a distance of 60.0 feet, to an elevation of 962.10 feet; thence rising at the rate of 7.087 per cent, for a distance of 197.97 feet to an elevation of 974.0 feet at a point opposite the North curb line of Second Street; thence rising at the rate of 10.0 per cent, for a distance of 231.46 feet, to an elevation of 997.15 feet; thence rising at the rate of 7.257 per cent, for a distance of 263.16 feet to an elevation of 1016.25 feet to a point opposite the North curb line of Third Street; thence rising at the rate of 4.668 per cent, for a distance of 187.41 feet, to an elevation of 1025.0 feet; thence rising at the rate of 2.35 per cent, for a distance of 127.54 feet, to an elevation of 1028.0 feet at a point opposite the North curb line of Fourth Street; thence rising at the rate of 0.418 per cent for a distance of 112.46 feet to an elevation of 1028.47 feet;

thence by a convex parabola, for a distance of 100.0 feet to an elevation of 1024.68 feet; thence falling at the rate of 8.0 per cent, for a distance of 78.26 feet, to an elevation of 1018.42 feet; thence falling at the rate of 2.646 per cent, for a distance of 30.28 feet to an elevation of 1017.62 at a point opposite the North curb line of Fifth Street.

SECTION 2---That the Borough Engineer enter the same upon the records of the Borough.

SECTION 3---That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, in so far as they conflict, are hereby repealed.
