ORDINANCE NUMBER 649 SEWER-WADDELL AVENUE AND FIRST STREET.

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the construction and installation of a public sanitary sewer in a portion of Waddell Avenue and First Street in the Borough of Donora, Pa.

WHEREAS the plans of the general sewer system of the Borough of Donora provide for the construction and installation of a sanitary sewer on Waddell Avenue in the said Borough; and

WHEREAS said proposed sewer has not been heretofore installed and installation is now deemed necessary by the said Borough of Donora; and

WHEREAS the Acts of the Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, appertaining thereto, authorize and empower the Council of the Borough of Donora, by proper ordinance, to cause sanitary sewers to be constructed and installed and the total cost and expense of the same to be assessed upon the owners of abutting properties by an equitable assessment and according to the benefits derived thereby; therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Donora, in regular meeting assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, as follows, to wit:

SECTION 1---That a public sanitary sewer be and the same is hereby authorized and directed to be constructed in Waddell Avenue in said Borough, from a manhole in the center of the intersection of Second Street and Waddell Avenue, South along Waddell Avenue, to its intersection with First Street; and thence along the center line of First Street, to a manhole in the center of the intersection of First and Lincoln Streets. Such sewer is to be constructed of 8 inch terra cotta pipe and according to the plans and specifications therefor as prepared by the Borough Street Commissioner, and approved by the Council of said Borough.

SECTION 2---That the proper officers of said Borough shall and are hereby authorized and empowered (after the lowest and best bid or bids therefor shall have been accepted by the Council in pursuance of public advertisement made) to execute a contract or contracts with the party or parties whose bid or bids

shall have been accepted by the Council as aforesaid, to construct the sewer authorized and directed to be constructed by this ordinance, in strict conformity with the plans and specifications aforesaid, and upon such party or parties giving to the said Borough the proper security for said work.

SECTION 3---That the cost and expense of the installation and construction of said sewer shall be ascertained upon the completion of the same, and assessed in accordance with the provisions of the several Acts of Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the ordinances of the Borough of Donora, upon the owners of the property abutting on both sides of said improvement, by an equal

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assessment on the foot front, abutting as aforesaid, such assessment to be estimated by the Borough Street Commissioner and approved by Council.
