

ORDINANCE NUMBER 650

PAVING-SYCAMORE ALLEY BETWEEN 3RD STREET AND 5TH STREET.

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing the curbing, grading, and paving with concrete, vitrified brick, block, or such other materials as Council may determine, of that portion of Sycamore Alley, lying between the North line of Third Street and the South line of Fifth Street; providing for the letting of contracts in connection with such work, and the assessment of the entire cost and expense thereof upon the owners of property abutting thereon, according to the foot front rule.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Burgess and Council of the Borough of Donora, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by virtue of the authority in them vested, as follows, to wit;

SECTION 1---That that portion of Sycamore Alley, lying between the North line of Third Street and the South line of Fifth Street, in the Borough of Donora, Pa., be and the same is hereby authorized and directed to be brought to the established grade and thereupon improved by a curbing and paving with concrete, vitrified brick, block or such other material as Council may determine, such paving to be made to conform with the grade or grades thereof, as heretofore fixed by ordinance of Council, and said improvement to be made according to the plans and specifications as prepared by the Borough Street Commissioner and approved by Council, and all work shall be done under the supervision of the Street Commissioner.

SECTION 2---That the proper officers of said Borough are hereby authorized and empowered (after the lowest and best bid or bids therefor shall have been accepted by Council in pursuance of public advertisement made), to execute a contract or contracts with the party or parties whose bid or bids have been accepted by said council, as aforesaid, to complete the improvement authorized and directed by this ordinance, in strict conformity with the plans and specifications of the Borough Engineer, so approved as aforesaid, and upon such party or parties giving to the said Borough proper security for said work.

SECTION 3---That the cost and expense of said improvement, including the necessary expense for the drainage thereof, shall be ascertained upon the completion of the same, and collected in the manner provided in the Borough Code and other Acts of Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the ordinances of the Borough of Donora, the entire cost and expense thereof, including the expense for the necessary drainage, from the owners of the real estate abutting on the improvement by an equal assessment on the foot front, abutting as aforesaid assessment to be estimated by the Borough Engineer, and to filed with the Secretary of the Borough.
