

ORDINANCE NUMBER 668  
AMENDMENT OF SECTION #3  
OF ORDINANCE #662.

AN ORDINANCE amending Section 3 of Ordinance No. 662 which regulates the business of peddling within the limits of the Borough of Donora,

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council and Chief Burgess of the Borough of Donora, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by virtue of the authority in them vested, as follows, to wit:

"SECTION 3---That hereafter the Secretary of the Borough of Donora is authorized to issue in the name of the Borough, to any individual applying therefor, a "peddler's license," authorizing the bearer to peddle within the limits of the Borough, when and after such applicant shall have paid to him, for the use of the Borough, the following fee or fees, to wit:

- A. License for one day (5 A. M. to 9 P. M.), the sum of \$5.00.
- B. License for one calendar week (6 days, exclusive of Sunday), the sum of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars.
- C. License for one calendar month, the sum of Ninety (\$90.00) Dollars.
- D. License for one calendar year, the sum of Seven Hundred Fifty (\$750.00) Dollars.

And provided further, that licenses shall be issued to individuals only, and not to any firm or corporation, as such."

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, in so far as they conflict, are hereby repealed.
