ORDINANCE NUMBER 677 SEWER-WOLF ALLEY.

AN ORDINANCE enlarging the sewer system of the Borough of Donora by the addition of a 36 inch storm water sewer in Wolf Alley.

WHEREAS the Borough of Donora is able at this time, through the Relief System, to obtain the services of labor without cost to the Borough; and

WHEREAS the cost of the materials necessary to complete the construction hereinafter authorized will be in excess of the sum of \$500.00 and therefore, will require the advertising for bids for the furnishing of the same; therefore.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Donora, in regular meeting of Council assembled, and it is ordained and enacted by authority of the same, as follows, to wit:

SECTION 1---That the sewer system of the Borough of Donora be and the same is hereby enlarged by the addition thereto of a 36 inch storm water sewer in Wolf Alley, beginning at the West end of the present 48 inch segment block sewer, near the West line of lots Nos. 232 and 319 in the Jenisee Land Company's Plan of South Donora; and running in a Westerly direction approximately 510 feet to the end of the present 36 inch concrete sewer near the East line of lots Nos. 260 and 347 in said Plan; and the Borough Engineer is directed to enter the same on said Borough sewer plan.

SECTION 2---That such storm water sewer be and the same is hereby authorized and directed to be constructed between the points fixed and following the courses fixed in Section 1 hereof, of reinforced concrete, of the diameter of 36 inches, and according to the specifications therefor as prepared by the Borough Engineer and approved by the Council of said Borough.

SECTION 3---That the proper officers of said Borough shall and are hereby authorized and empowered (after the lowest and best bid therefor shall have been accepted by the Council in pursuance of public advertisement made), to execute a contract with the party whose bid shall have been accepted by the Council as aforesaid, for the furnishing of the materials required to construct the sewer authorized and directed to be constructed by this ordinance.

SECTION 4---That all the labor necessary to the proper installation of the sewer hereinbefore authorized to be constructed shall be performed, without cost to the Borough, by the persons whose services are furnished through the relief or welfare agencies now in operation in the Borough but under the strict supervision of the Borough Street Commissioner, and the cost of the material therefor shall be paid from the general funds of the Borough as and

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when provided in the contract therefor.

SECTION 5---All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict herewith.
