## ORDINANCE NO. 709

AN ORDINANCE, dedicating as a public street or highway, a newly opened road traversing Palmer Park in the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pa.

WHEREAS heretofore the Borough of Donora, by proper legal proceedings, incorporated into the limits of the Borough of Donora a tract of land known as "Palmer Park"; and

WHEREAS, as part of the consideration of the grant of the title to such land to the Borough for park purposes, the Borough was to lay out and open to the public a road or highway which would serve as a connecting link between Route No. 837 and an existing township road at a point near the Trojner property in Carroll Township, so that a protion of such township road thereby rendered unnecessary might be vacated; and

WHEREAS such road has been laid out and is now in use by the traveling public but has never been formally dedicated to public use; therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Donora, in regular meeting assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by virtue of the authority in them vested, as follows, to wit:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> That the newly constructed road, more particularly shown on blue print hereto attached and which road is of the width, length, and in the location as shown by such blue print, be and the same is hereby dedicated as a public highway of the Borough of Donora.

SECTION 2. That the Borough Engineer be and he is hereby authorized and directed to enter as such road as a public road upon the official maps of the Borough of Donora.
