ORDINANCE NO. 717

AN ORDINANCE providing for the construction and installation of a six inch terra cotta sewer in Brokaw Avenue.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council or the Borough of Donora, in regular meeting assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by virtue of the authority in them vested, as follows, to wit:

SECTION 1. That a public sanitary sewer be and the same is hereby authorized and directed to be constructed in Brokaw Avenue in said Borough, from the middle of lot No. 192 in the Jenisee Land Company's Plan of South Donora to the center of lot No. 186 in said plan. Such Sewer is to be constructed of six inch terra cotta sewer pipe, in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor as prepared by the Borough Street Commissioner and approved by Council.

SECTION 2. That, under supervision of the Borough Engineer, the employees of the Borough of Donoza be and they are hereby authorized to construct such sewer in conformity with the plans and specifications as prepared by the Borough Engineer and approved by Council.

SECTION 3. That the cost and expense of the installation and construction of said sewer shall be ascertained upon the completion of the same, and assessed, in accordance with the provisions of the several Acts of Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the ordinances of the Borough of Donora, upon the owners of the property abutting on the upper side of Brokaw Avenue along such improvement, being lots Nos. 186, 188, 190 and 192 in the Jenisee Land Company's Plan of the Borough of Donora, according to the foot front rule; such assessment to be estimated by the Borough Street Commissioner and approved by Council.

SECTION 4. That after the approval of such assessment, as aforesaid, the Secretary of the Borough be and he is hereby authorized to notify all property holders so assessed to make payment of their respective assessments within thirty (30) days from the date of such notice, and after the expiration of such notice period shall cause to be delivered a statement of all such assessments as shall remain unpaid to the Borough Solicitor, who shall thereupon cause a municipal claim or lien therefor, in the name of the Borough, to be filed against the owners of the property and the property for which the assessments shall remain so unpaid, and proceed to collect the same in the manner provided by law.
