

ORDINANCE NUMBER 73

SEWER--LINDEN ALLEY SEVENTH TO EIGHTH STREET

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the adoption and construction of a public sewer on Linden Alley, from Seventh to Eighth streets, in the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania.

Whereas, It appears by the petition and affidavit, accepted and approved by the Burgess and Council of the Borough of Donora, that a majority of the property owners abutting on the West side of Linden Alley, between Seventh and Eighth streets have petitioned the Burgess and Council of said borough to enact an ordinance authorizing the adoption and construction of a public sewer, therefore,

Be it ordained and enacted by the Burgess and Council of Washington and State of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section 1. That a public sewer be adopted and constructed on Linden Alley between Seventh and Eighth streets, in said borough, being a total distance of 480 feet; that such sewer shall be constructed of terra cotta sewer pipe of the diameter of 10 inches and according to the plans and specifications of the Borough Engineer, approved by the President of the Council and the Committee on highways and sewers.

Section 2. That the President of the Council and the Chairman of the Committee on Highways and Sewers are hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and receive proposals for the construction of said sewer as aforesaid; and they are hereby authorized upon the approval of the same by the Council, to let contract or contracts to any responsible party or parties, such party or parties to give satisfactory security to complete the work in strict conformity with the plans and specifications which shall be furnished by the Borough Engineer, so approved as aforesaid, and work shall be done under the direction and supervision of the Borough Engineer.

Section 3. That the costs and expenses of the adoption and construction of said sewer shall be ascertained upon the completion of the same, and be assessed proportionately upon the properties adjoining and abutting on the West side of Linden Alley, according to the foot front rule, and collected in accordance with the provisions of the act of Assembly approved May 15th, 1889, relative thereto and regulating the same.

Section 4. That any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed so far as the same effects this ordinance.
