ORDINANCE NO. 749

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the installation and construction of a sanitary sewer in McKean Avenue from a point opposite lot No. 11 in block No. 61 of the Union Improvement Company's plan to a junction with the present sanitary sewer at Kenyon Alley.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Donora, in legal meeting assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by virtue of the authority in them vested, as follows, to wit:

SECTION 1. That, if such permit has not already been procured, the proper officers of the Borough are hereby directed and authorized to procure the necessary permit from the State Sanitary Water Board to install the sewer herein authorized.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That, as and when such permit has been procured, the proper officers of the Borough of Donora are hereby authorized and directed, either by Borough employees or by contract, to cause a six inch terra cotta sewer to be installed in McKean Avenue, from a point opposite lot No. 11 in block No. 61 of the Union Improvement Company's plan of said Borough to a junction with the present sanitary sewer in Kenyon Alley. Such work is to be done under the supervision of the Borough Engineer and in strict conformity with his plans and specifications, as approved by Council.

SECTION 3. That the total cost and expense of said improvement shall be ascertained upon the completion thereof and, in the manner provided by the Borough Code and other Acts of Assembly in such cases made and provided, assessed as a sewage tax upon the properties adjoining or adjacent thereto, according to the foot front rule, and collected in the manner prescribed by law.
