

ORDINANCE NO. 778

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing the curbing, grading, and paving with asphalt or such other materials as Council may determine, of McKean Avenue, between Twelfth and Thirteenth Streets, and providing for the assessment of two-thirds of the total cost and expense thereof upon the owners of property abutting thereon, according to the foot-front rule.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Donora, in regular meeting assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by virtue of the authority in them vested, as follows, to wit:

SECTION 1. That that portion of McKean Avenue in the Borough of Donora, lying between Twelfth and Thirteenth Streets, be and the same is hereby authorized and directed to be brought to the established grade, and improved by curbing, and paving with asphalt on a slag base, such paving to be made to conform with such established grade, and such improvement to be made according to the plans and specifications as prepared by the Borough Engineer and approved by Council; such work to be done under the supervision of the Borough Engineer.

SECTION 2. The proper officers of said Borough are hereby authorized and empowered (after the lowest and best bid or bids therefor shall have been accepted by Council in pursuance of public advertisement made), to execute a contract or contracts with the party or parties whose bid or bids have been accepted by said Council, as aforesaid, to complete the improvement authorized and directed by this ordinance in strict conformity with the plans and specifications of the Borough Engineer, so approved as aforesaid, and upon such party or parties giving to the said Borough property security for said work.

SECTION 3. That the cost and expense of said improvement, including the necessary expense for the drainage thereof, shall be ascertained upon the completion of the same, and collected in the manner provided in the Borough Code and other Acts of Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the ordinances of the Borough of Donora, two-thirds of the cost and expense thereof, including the expense for the necessary drainage thereof, from the owners of real estate abutting on the improvement by an equal assessment on the foot front, abutting as aforesaid; said assessment to be estimated by the Borough Engineer and to be filed with the Borough Secretary and approved by Council; the remaining cost and expense to be paid by the Borough from funds properly appropriated for such purpose.
