

ORDINANCE NO. 790

AN ORDINANCE establishing the grade of Taylor Alley.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Donora, in regular meeting assembled, and it is ordained by virtue of the authority in them vested as follows:

SECTION 1. That the grade of Taylor Alley for North and South curb lines alike be and the same is hereby established as follows, to wit:

Beginning at East line of Linden Alley at an elevation of 786.0 feet; thence ascending at the rate of 1.0% for a distance of 50 feet to an elevation of 786.5 feet; thence ascending at the rate of 2.333% for a distance of 150 feet to an elevation of 790.0 feet; thence ascending at the rate of 6.4% for a distance of 193.52 feet to an elevation of 802.38 feet at a point on the West line of lots 16 and 20 in block 72.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
