

ORDINANCE NO. 815

AN ORDINANCE appointing the Borough Planning Commission as a Zoning Commission.

WHEREAS the Borough of Donora, by action of its Council, heretofore adopted an ordinance known and designated as Ordinance No. 807, creating a Planning Commission for the Borough; and

WHEREAS the Act of June 29, 1923, P. L. 957, Section 6, (P. S. 53, Section 15736) gives the Council authority to create a Zoning Commission and, where a Borough Planning Commission already exists, to appoint such Commission as a Zoning Commission, and it is now the desire of the Borough that such Planning Commission be vested with the powers by the Act of Assembly vested in a Zoning Commission: therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Donora, in regular meeting assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by virtue of the authority in them vested, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the Borough Planning Commission is hereby appointed as a Zoning Commission and is hereby vested with all the powers, duties and obligations by the Acts of Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in such cases made and provided to be vested in a Zoning Commission.
