

ORDINANCE NO. 817

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the purchase of material for repair of garbage furnace.

WHEREAS the garbage furnace of the Borough of Donora requires immediate repair; and

WHEREAS after due advertisement made, the Harbison-Walker Refractories Company, of Pittsburgh, Pa., submitted the lowest bid for the furnishing of the required materials; and

WHEREAS Council has, by proper action, unanimously ordered and directed that such bid be accepted and that an ordinance authorizing a contract for the furnishing of such material be prepared and presented; therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Donora, in regular meeting assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by virtue of the authority in them vested, as follows, to wit:

SECTION 1. That the proper Borough officers enter into a contract with the Harbison-Walker Refractories Company for the purchase and immediate delivery to the Borough of the necessary repair materials for the garbage furnace, as outlined in the bid of such Company, at the prices set forth in such bid.

SECTION 2. That, as and when such materials have been delivered to the Borough in conformity with such bid and contract, the proper officers of the Borough issue a warrant to the said Harbison-Walker Refractories Company, drawn upon the Borough funds heretofore appropriated for such purpose, and in the amount as set forth in such bid and contract.
