

ORDINANCE NO. 888

AN ORDINANCE, Repealing Section 6, Part I, of Ordinance No. 839, Relating To Providing Revenue For The Borough Of Donora, By Imposing Fees And Taxes Upon And Regulating Certain Amusements, Businesses, Entertainments, Etc., And Prescribing The Manner Of Collecting The Same And Imposing Penalties For Violations.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Borough of Donora, in regular meeting assembled, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by virtue of the authority in the same, as follows, to wit: THAT

Section 6, Part I, of Ordinance No. 839 relating to the imposing of an annual tax on bowling alleys and pool tables, be and the same is hereby repealed.
