

ORDINANCE NO. 893

AN ORDINANCE CLASSIFYING, CONFIRMING AND FIXING THE SALARIES OF THE POLICE OF DONORA.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, by the Borough of Donora, in regular meeting assembled, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by virtue of the authority vested in the same, as follows, to wit: THAT

SECTION I.

The Police of the Borough of Donora be and are hereby classified as a Chief of Police, a Lieutenant, a Sergeant and First, Second and Third Year Patrolman.

SECTION II.

The Police of the Borough of Donora shall receive for their respective services, the following monthly compensation, payable bi-weekly in accordance with present system which Council may change at any time by motion:

Chief of Police	\$375.64
Lieutenant	344.00.
Sergeant	336.00.
Third Year Patrolmen	326.14
Second Year Patrolmen	321.14
First Year Patrolmen	316.84

SECTION III

A majority of Council in regular meeting assembled, may by motion hereafter, when Council deem it proper and general conditions warrant, either increase or decrease all or any of the salaries fixed above in an amount not to exceed fifteen (15%) percent, provided in the event of an increase the expenditure authorized shall not exceed the budget appropriation for such purpose.

SECTION IV.

Any Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, insofar as it conflicts with the Ordinance.
