

ORDINANCE NUMBER 9

EIGHTH STREET SEWER

AN ORDINANCE to authorize the construction of a public sewer, in the borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, beginning at a point on the Monongahela river and extending westwardly to and along Eighth Street, thence to and along Thompson Avenue to the center of lot of J. D. Miller, thence across said lot to Heslep Avenue, a total distance of two thousand (2,000) surface feet; and also to authorize the president and chairman of the committee on highways and sewers of the town council of said borough of Donora, to advertise for bids, and to execute and deliver contracts for the construction of said sewer; and for the assessments of the cost and expense for the construction of the same, according to the act of the general assembly of May 16th, A. D., 1891, in such cases made and provided.

SECTION 1. Be it ordained and enacted by the borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, in council assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, that a certain sewer be constructed in the borough of Donora in the following manner and along the route as hereinafter set forth; beginning at a point on the Monongahela river, in a public road which leads to and meets the said Monongahela river at the Castner Ferry landing and thence continues along said public road in a westerly direction, across the property of the Union Steel Company and the P. V. & C. R. R. Co.'s tracks to and along Eighth street to Thompson Avenue thence along Eighth street to Thompson avenue, thence along Thompson avenue to the center of a lot belonging to J. D. Miller, which abutts on said Thompson avenue, said center of lot being 282 feet from the southwesterly corner of Eighth Street and Thompson avenue, thence continues in a westerly direction across said lot of J. D. Miller to Heslep avenue; the distance from said certain point on the Monongahela river to the lot of J. D. Miller being about 1,700 feet and across said lot to Heslep avenue being 300 feet, a total distance of 2,000 feet.

SECTION 2. The sewer from said certain point on the Monongahela river to lot of J. D. Miller, being in distance or length about 1,700 feet, as aforesaid, shall be constructed with tile sewer pipe 24 inches in diameter; and from said certain point in J. D. Miller lot to Heslep avenue, being a distance as aforesaid of 300 feet, shall be constructed of tile sewer pipe 18 inches in diameter.

SECTION 3. The president and chairman of the committee on highways and sewers of said borough of Donora are hereby directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said sewer, according to the plans and specifications prepared and approved by the borough engineer and said chairman of the committee on highways and sewers; and said

president and chairman of said committee are hereby authorized and empowered to execute and deliver for and on behalf of said borough proper contracts and agreements for the construction thereof, upon such terms as the council shall approve and direct.

SECTION 4. The benefits, damages, costs and expense of the construction of said sewer shall be assessed and collected according to the act of assembly of May 16th, A. D. 1891, in such cases made and provided.

SECTION 5. That the within proposed ordinance shall be published, at length, in the....., a newspaper of general circulation in said county of Washington, Pennsylvania, and that not less than twelve of said ordinances shall be posted at various and conspicuous places in said borough of Donora, at least ten days before the same shall go into effect.
