

ORDINANCE NO. ⁹²⁴ ~~507~~

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE GRADING, CURBING AND PAVING OF THE PORTIONS OF ALLEYS HEREINAFTER DESIGNATED AND PROVIDING FOR THE ASSESSMENT OF TWO-THIRDS OF THE COST THEREOF ON THE OWNERS OF ABUTTING PROPERTY, ACCORDING TO THE FOOT FRONT RULE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Donora, in regular meeting assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by virtue of the authority in them vested, as follows, to wit:

SECTION I. That the following alleys and portions of alleys between the points designated be and the same are hereby authorized and directed to be curbed where necessary and paved with such material as council may hereafter determine. Such alleys shall be graded to conform with the grade or grades thereof as have been or shall be properly established and said improvement shall be made according to such plans and specifications as shall be approved by council and all work shall be done under the supervision of the Borough Street Commissioner and Borough Engineer:-

LAWRENCE ALLEY from the Southern line of Bradford Alley to its joinder with Watkins Avenue.

WESTERN PORTION OF WOLF ALLEY from the inlet to the thirty (30) inch sewer now in place in the alley to the Eastern line of Modisette Avenue.

SECTION II. That the proper officers of the said Borough are hereby authorized and empowered, after the lowest and best bid therefore shall have been accepted by Council in pursuance to public advertisement made, to execute a contract or contracts with the successful bidder to complete the improvement authorized and directed by this ordinance. Such contract or contracts shall, inter alia, provide for the filing of proper bonds by the contractor or contractors.

SECTION III. That the cost and expense of such improvement, including the necessary expense of the drainage thereof shall be ascertained upon the completion of the work and two-thirds thereof shall and is hereby directed to be assessed against the owners of abutting property according to the foot front rule. Such assessment shall be estimated by the Borough Engineer and approved by council. The remaining one-third of the costs thereof shall be paid by the funds appropriated or to be appropriated for such purposes.

SECTION IV. That, upon approval of such assessment, the required notice of and demand for payment of such assessment shall be given to each property owner involved by the Borough Secretary. In the event any person so assessed shall fail to pay such assessment within the time specified in such notice, such claims shall be placed in the hands of the Borough Solicitor for collection in the manner set forth in the Acts of Assembly in such cases made and provided.
