

ORDINANCE NUMBER 97

HESLEP AVENUE GRADE

AN ORDINANCE fixing and establishing the grade of Heslep avenue, in the borough of Donora, Washington county, Pennsylvania.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Donora, in the County of Washington and State of Pennsylvania, in regular meeting assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section 1. That the grade of Heslep avenue in said borough, be and the same is hereby fixed and established as follows, to wit:

East curb line--Beginning at the North curb line of Highland avenue, at an elevation of 874.24 feet, and rising at the rate of 9.047 per cent for a distance of 227.26 feet to an elevation of 894.8 feet; thence falling at the rate of 3 per cent for a distance of 60 feet to an elevation of 893.00 feet at the south curb line of Seventh street; thence beginning at the north curb line of Seventh street, at an elevation of 888 feet, and rising at the rate of 1.3 per cent for a distance of 30 feet to an elevation of 888.39 feet; thence falling at the rate of 7.6 per cent for a distance of 202.43 feet to an elevation of 873 feet; thence rising at the rate of 1.25 per cent for a distance of 40 feet to an elevation of 873.50 feet, at a point opposite the south curb line of Eighth street; thence level for a distance of 24.09 feet to a point opposite the north curb line of Eighth street; thence rising at the rate of 9.623 per cent for a distance of 145.48 feet to an elevation of 887.50 feet; thence falling at the rate of 4.166 per cent for a distance of 60 feet to an elevation of 885 feet, at the south curb line of Eighth street.

West curb line--Beginning at the North curb line of Highland avenue, at an elevation of 876.45 feet, and rising at the rate of 6.65 per cent for a distance of 40 feet to an elevation of 879.11 feet; thence rising at the rate of 9.047 per cent for a distance of 173.45 feet to an elevation of 894.8 feet; thence falling at the rate of 1.518 per cent for a distance of 52.7 feet to an elevation of 894 feet at the south curb line of Seventh Street, thence beginning at the northeast curb line of Norman street, at an elevation of 890.10 feet, and falling at the rate of 7.6 per cent for a distance of 218.41 feet to an elevation of 873.50 feet; thence rising at the rate of 1.25 per cent for a distance of 40 feet to an elevation of 874 feet, at the south curb line of Eighth street; thence beginning at the north curb line of Eighth street, at an elevation of 874 feet, and rising at the rate of 9.623 per cent for a distance of 145.48 feet to an elevation of 888 feet; thence

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falling at the rate of 3.333 per cent for a distance of 60 feet to an elevation of 886 feet, at a point opposite the south curb line of Eighth street.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with any of the provisions of this ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed.
