

ORDINANCE NO. 1038

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING TEMPORARY MINOR REPAIRS TO ST. NICHOLAS DRIVE FROM HESLEP AVENUE TO FIFTH AVENUE IN THE DONORA PLACE PLAN, AND PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE COST AND EXPENSE OF THE SAME FROM THE GENERAL FUNDS OF THE BOROUGH.

WHEREAS, St. Nicholas Drive is an unimproved road in a bad state of disrepair; and

WHEREAS, Donora Borough Council is of the opinion that the cost to the Borough of Donora will not permit a paving or an improvement of a permanent nature to said St. Nicholas Drive at this time; and

WHEREAS, it is not the intention of Council to presently convert St. Nicholas Drive into a permanent improved street; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary that some temporary minor repairs be made to said St. Nicholas Drive,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Donora and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same as follows, to wit:

SECTION 1. That St. Nicholas Drive between Heslep Avenue and Fifth Avenue in the Donora Place Plan be and the same is hereby authorized and directed to be temporarily repaired with such material as council may hereafter determine.

SECTION 2. That the proper officers of said borough are hereby authorized and empowered, after the lowest and best bid therefore shall have

been accepted by council in pursuance to public advertisement made, to execute a contract or contracts with the successful bidder or bidders to complete the repairs authorized and directed by this ordinance. Such contract or contracts shall, inter alia, provide for the filing of proper bonds by the contractor or contractors.

SECTION 3. That upon the completion of such work and approval thereof by the Borough Engineer and proper officers of the Borough, the Borough shall pay, by warrant drawn upon the general funds of the Borough, to the person, firm or corporation entitled to receive the same, the amount authorized by Council to be paid for such repairs.
