

ORDINANCE NUMBER 108

KENNETH STREET GRADE

AN ORDINANCE fixing and establishing the grade of Kenneth Street, in the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Donora, in the County of Washington and State of Pennsylvania, in regular meeting assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section 1. That the grade of Kenneth Street in said borough, be and the same is hereby fixed and established as follows, to-wit:

North Curb Line--Beginning at the West curb line of Kenric Avenue, at an elevation of 893.50 feet thence rising at the rate of 10.259 per cent for a distance of 506.17 feet to an elevation of 945.43 feet, at the East curb line of Allen Avenue.

South Curb Line--Beginning at the West curb line of Kenric Avenue, at an elevation of 896.50 feet, and rising at the rate of 5.24 per cent. for a distance of 75 feet to an elevation of 900.43 feet, thence rising at the rate of 10.259 per cent for a distance of 391.17 feet to an elevation of 940.56 feet; thence rising at the rate of 12.8 per cent for a distance of 40 feet to an elevation of 945.68 feet, at the East curb line of Allen Avenue.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.
