

ORDINANCE NO. 1080

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF DONORA, WASHINGTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REGULATING AND CONTROLLING THE INSTALLATION OF ON-LOT DISPOSAL SEWAGE SYSTEMS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by Council of the Borough of Donora, in regular meeting assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by virtue of the authority in them vested, as follows, to wit:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation or any agents thereof to install on any property in the Borough of Donora an on-lot sewage disposal system or to construct any building in which a disposal system is to be installed, or which is to be serviced by an on-lot disposal system without complying with the Pennsylvania Sewage Act of 1966 (P. L. 1535) and the rules and regulations adopted pursuant thereto and without first obtaining a permit indicating that the site, plans and specifications of such system are in compliance with said Act and its rules and regulations.

SECTION 2. All on-lot sewage disposal systems, regardless of the size of the lot, will be subject to the provisions of Section 1 of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. A fee shall be paid to the Borough of Donora at the time of making application for an on-lot sewage disposal system in an amount set from time to time by Resolution of the Borough Council.

SECTION 4. An on-lot sewage disposal system shall mean and include all septic tanks, or any other similar method by which sewage is treated and discharged on the lot serviced by said system.

SECTION 5. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this Ordinance or the rules, regulations or standards promulgated thereunder

shall upon conviction thereof in a summary proceeding be sentenced to pay a fine or penalty of not less than \$100.00 and costs, and not more than \$300.00 and costs, or in default thereof, shall be confined to the County Jail for a period not to exceed 30 days.
