

ORDINANCE NO. 1082

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 934, May 19, 1958, BY PROVIDING FOR PARKING METER ENFORCEMENT COURTESY BOXES AND PAYMENT OF VIOLATIONS BY USE THEREOF.

IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF DONORA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Parking meter enforcement courtesy boxes shall be installed in convenient locations in the parking meter zones of the Borough of Donora.

SECTION 2. The owner or operator of any vehicle receiving a notice that such vehicle has been parked in violation of the provisions of Ordinance 934, May 19, 1958, may pay as a penalty for and in full satisfaction of such violation twenty-five (25¢) cents placed in the envelope police tag and deposited or caused to be deposited in the parking meter enforcement courtesy box; provided, however, that each hour after the first hour of violation shall be considered <sup>2</sup>separate violation. The failure of such owner or operator to make such payment by use of the parking meter enforcement courtesy box shall subject such owner or operator to the same fines and penalties provided for in Ordinance 934 or as may be established from time to time by the Borough of Donora.
