

ORDINANCE NUMBER 109

WATKINS AVENUE GRADE

AN ORDINANCE fixing and establishing the grade of Watkins Avenue, in the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Town Council of the Borough of Donora, in the County of Washington and State of Pennsylvania, in regular meeting assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same.

Section 1. That the grade of Watkins Avenue, in said borough, be and the same is hereby fixed and established as follows, to-wit:

East Curb Line,--Beginning at a point opposite the South line of Lot No. 50, in Block No. 44 at an elevation of 883.50 feet; thence falling at the rate of 4.5 per cent for a distance of 211.02 feet to an elevation of 874 feet; thence rising at the rate of 2.07 per cent for a distance of 251.57 feet to an elevation of 879 feet; thence rising at the rate of 6.5 per cent for a distance of 200 feet to an elevation of 892 feet; thence rising at the rate of 2.058 per cent for a distance of 310 feet to an elevation of 898.38 feet, at the South curb line of First Street.

West Curb Line,--Beginning at a point opposite the South line of Lot No. 50, in Block No. 44 at an elevation of 884 feet, and falling at the rate of 4.5 per cent for a distance of 206.73 feet to an elevation of 874.69 feet; thence level for a distance of 7.31 feet to the South line of a fifteen foot alley; thence beginning at the North line of said fifteen foot alley, at an elevation of 875.05 feet, and rising at the rate of 2.07 per cent for a distance of 214.97 feet to an elevation of 879.50 feet; thence rising at the rate of 6.5 per cent for a distance of 200 feet to an elevation of 892.50 feet; thence rising at the rate of 2.058 per cent for a distance of 260 feet to an elevation of 897.85 feet; thence rising at the rate of 6.06 per cent for a distance of 50 feet to an elevation of 900.88 feet, at the South curb line of First Street.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.
