ORDINANCE NO. 1091

AN ORDINANCE relating to the management of Palmer Park and prescribing regulations for the conduct of persons while in such park, and prescribing penalties for the violation of such regulations.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by Council of the Borough of Donora, in regular meeting assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by virtue of the authority in them vested, as follows, to wit:

SECTION 1. The following rules and regulations are hereby established for the management and protection of Palmer Park, hereinafter designated "the park".

- 1. The park shall be open daily to the public between the hours of seven o'clock A. M. and ten o'clock, P. M. At ten o'clock, P. M. all activities in the park shall cease and all persons in the park shall leave as soon as possible thereafter. No person, other than authorized employes thereof, shall be in the park at any time between ten o'clock, P. M. and seven o'clock A. M. on the following morning.
- 2. No person shall injure, deface, remove, cut or damage any of the trees, plants, shrubs, turf, buildings, structures or fixtures therein, or any property of the Borough located within the park.
- 3. No person shall remove any bench, seat or table from the park or change the location thereof without permission from Council.
- 4. No person shall conduct himself within the park so as to annoy any other person using the park for recreational purposes.
- 5. No person shall dispose of any waste or garbage in the park except in receptacles designated for the respective purposes. All persons using the park shall dispose of all waste and garbage left by them in such proper receptacles.
- 6. No person shall injure, deface or destroy any notice, rule or regulation posted at any place within the park by Council or any other

authority of the Borough. Nor shall any person post, at any place within the park, any notice or placard other than by authority of Council.

7. No person shall set or maintain any fire in the park except in stoves or fireplaces maintained for the purpose and located by authority of Council.

SECTION 2. Any person who shall violate any of the rules and regulations contained in this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) and costs of prosecution for each and every offense. PROVIDED: each day's violation of any of the provisions of such section shall constitute a separate offense.
