

ORDINANCE NO. 1106A

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF DONORA, WASHINGTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, VACATING A PORTION OF HILL AVENUE BETWEEN TENTH STREET IN THE ALLEN PLAN OF LOTS TO FROST ALLEY IN THE DONORA PLACE PLAN OF LOTS IN THE BOROUGH OF DONORA, WASHINGTON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Donora, in regular meeting assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by virtue of the authority in them vested, as follows, to-wit:

Section 1. That the portion of Hill Avenue in the Borough of Donora, Pennsylvania, which lies between Tenth Street in the Allen Plan of Lots and Frost Alley in the Donora Place Plan of Lots, be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent herewith.
