ORDINANCE NO. 130

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING MINIMUM STANDARDS GOVERNING MINIMUM PLUMBING STANDARDS IN TERMS OF PERFORMANCE OBJECTIVES, IMPLEMENTED BY SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS, WHICH WILL PROVIDE REASONABLE SAFEGUARDS FOR SANITATION TO PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH AGAINST THE HAZARDS OF INADEQUATE, DEFECTIVE OR UNSANITARY PLUMBING INSTALLATIONS; AND REPEALING EXISTING ORDINANCE NUMBERS 1052, 1073, 1087, 1088 and 1099 OF THE BOROUGH OF DONORA, STATE OF PENNSYLVANIA.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

Section One: Adoption of Plumbing Code.

That a certain document, 3 copies of which are on file in the Office of the Borough of Donora, being marked and designated as The BOCA Basic Plumbing Code, Second Edition, 1970, including the 1971 Annual Supplement, as published by the Building Officials and Code Administrators International, Inc., be and is hereby adopted as the Plumbing Code of the Borough of Donora in the State of Pennsylvania; for the control of buildings and structures as herein provided; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms are hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof, as if fully set out in this ordinance, with the additions, insertions and changes, if any prescribed in Section 2 of this Ordinance.

Section Two: Additions, Insertions and Changes.

That the following sections are hereby revised as follows:

Section P-102.0 (Page 1, first line) Insert (November 9, 1972).  
Section P-308.2 (Page 17, third line) Insert (100 feet).  
Section P-313.3 (Page 18, second and third lines) Insert (3 feet in second line and 4 feet in third line).

Section Three: Inconsistent Ordinances Repealed.

That Ordinance Numbers 1052, 1073, 1087, 1088 and 1099 of the Borough of Donora and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section Four: Saving Clause.

That nothing in this Ordinance or in the Plumbing Code hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding impending in

any court, or any rights acquitted, or liability incurred, or any cause of causes or action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed as cited in Section 3 of this Ordinance; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this Ordinance.

Section Five: Date of Effect.

That the Secretary of the Borough of Donora shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and cause the same to be published as required by law; and this Ordinance shall take effect 30 days after approval as so certified.
