

ORDINANCE NO. 1153

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 1 AND 5 of ORDINANCE NO. 1123, BEING AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE MOVING INTO OR REMOVAL FROM THE BOROUGH OF DONORA, THE TRANSPORTATION INTO OR REMOVAL OF PERSONAL PROPERTY, THE OCCUPATION OF ANY PREMISES LOCATED IN THE BOROUGH OF DONORA, REQUIRING PERMITS TO MOVE INTO OR MOVE FROM THE BOROUGH OF DONORA AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the Borough of Donora, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by and with the authority of the same:

Section 1. That SECTION 1 of Ordinance No. 1123 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1. On and after the effective date of this Ordinance, no person, firm or corporation shall move into the Borough, or move from place to place within the Borough, or remove from the Borough of Donora, or cause his personal property to be so moved or removed, from any house, dwelling or other building, within the Borough of Donora, Washington County, Pennsylvania, to any site or location either in or outside the Borough of Donora, without first having obtained a permit therefor from the Secretary of the Borough of Donora.

Section 2. That SECTION 5 of Ordinance No. 1123 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 5. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to transport or remove its own or the personal property of another person which said person is moving into, or moving from place to place within the Borough, or removing from a house, dwelling or other building within the Borough of Donora unless such person so moving into or from place to place within the Borough, or removing from the said Borough of Donora shall

have first obtained the permit as hereinbefore provided. It shall be the duty of such person, firm or corporation transporting or removing the personal property of itself or of another person to, within, or from the Borough of Donora to ascertain that the person, firm or corporation whose property is to be so transported, or removed, has obtained the permit as hereinbefore required.
