

ORDINANCE NO. 1188

(6 of 1980)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF DONORA AMENDING ORDINANCE 1037 ENTITLED "THE BOROUGH OF DONORA CANVASSING AND SOLICITING ORDINANCE."

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Council of the Borough of Donora as follows:

SECTION ONE: That Ordinance 1037 is hereby amended by the inclusion of the following sentence after Paragraph two of Section Five: "For each day that the Applicant wishes to solicit/canvass in the Borough, he shall pay the sum of \$5.00 per day for and to the use of the Borough. The Borough Secretary shall not issue the required identification card until such time that the Applicant deposits the entire sum due."

SECTION TWO: That Ordinance 1037 is amended by the deletion of Paragraph four of Section Six and the inclusion of the following: "Soliciting/canvassing shall be permitted from 10:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. and at no other hours."

SECTION THREE: That Section Nine of Ordinance 1037 is amended by the deletion, in its entirety, of same. Section Nine shall henceforth read as follows: "Any person who shall violate the terms of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon conviction before the District Justice, be subject to the costs of prosecution and a fine of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00). In default of payment of such costs and fine, he shall be sentenced to confinement in the Washington County Jail for a term not to exceed thirty (30) days."

SECTION FOUR: All prior Ordinances, or parts thereof, inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
